## INVESTING IN GOD'S MISSION THROUGH GRACE

Soon, when construction is finished, we will have an open, inviting narthex where we can gather as a community, welcome new faces, and connect with old friends. The next phase of capital stewardship builds on that renewed energy to continue to improve our physical facilities (without any new debt!), service and pay down our existing debt, and tithe in support of God's work beyond Grace's campus.



## Improvements to Our Campus

The 500 Years in Hope and Grace capital campaign will allow the church to continue to be good stewards of our campus and parsonages by tackling a number of projects without any new debt! Particular focus will be paid to Brown Hall, the kitchen, the courtyard between the office and Brown Hall, and the doors and windows that separate those spaces. Additional items, as funds are available, include deferred maintenance on campus such as walkways, plumbing, the Towle Way Parsonage (more plumbing!) as well as updates to spaces adjacent to our current construction that will need improvement (the alley, floors in the Education Wing, etc.) This much needed attention to some of our most used program and fellowship spaces will make positive improvements to how these spaces are used and experienced by Grace and the wider community. The stronger the campaign response, the more we will be able to accomplish!

Servicing Existing Debt

We also seek to be responsible stewards of our financial resources. The 500 Years in Hope and Grace capital campaign includes an intentional effort to service and reduce our existing debt. This intentionality will allow our Operating Budget to be freed to pursue its purpose, namely the doing of ministry! Missional questions about staffing and programs are then less encumbered by mortgage concerns.

The stronger the campaign response, the more our debt is reduced!

## Giving Generously to Others

Part of what makes Grace Lutheran Church an exciting, fulfilling faith community is our commitment to supporting God's work in the world. 500 Years in Hope and Grace brings that same spirit by committing 10% of the financial resources raised to continue to support the the South Sudan Clinic of the Campaign for the ELCA. This trade school, ministry center, and medical clinic for women and children is being completed due to gifts like ours from our last campaign. It now needs to be outfitted with all of the supplies and equipment necessary for their mission. What would our tithe support? Exam tables, desks, chairs, blood pressure cuffs, cabinets, mechanical operating tables, defibrillators, and more! Perhaps our response will be strong enough to supply them with anesthesia machines and a portable ultrasound! Think of the difference this gift could make!
